



# What tests you need to take before you attend the Wales v Albania match

You'll need to have two negative COVID tests to attend. This pack contains two tests:

1. A COVID test – called a polymerase chain reaction (PCR) **and**
2. A rapid COVID test – called a lateral flow test (LFT). Children under 11 do not need to be tested.

**If you have been informed by Test, Trace, Protect to isolate you can NOT attend the event even if you have tested negative. You are required to self-isolate as a close contact.**

## Test 1

Please take your PCR test on one of the following days:

31 May / 1 June / 2 June / 3 June or 4 June

It's very important that you register the PCR test as directed in the instructions. If you don't, you won't receive your test results.

Please take a screenshot of the confirmation that you've successfully registered your test – you may need this later. If you're unable to take a screen shot, the confirmation should stay on screen if you try to register again.

You'll need to send your test back at a priority post box and should receive your results 48-72 hours later.

If your test result is positive you'll need to self-isolate immediately for 10 days and will be unable to attend the event. There's more information about self-isolation here: [gov.wales/self-isolation](http://gov.wales/self-isolation)

If your test result is negative you need to keep the email or text as proof to enter the event. If you do not get your test result back before the event, you will need to show proof that you have registered your PCR test. This is the screen shot of the confirmation that you have successfully registered your test.

## Test 2

You will need to take your LF test on Friday 4 June or Saturday 5 June.

You should do this test at home and it will give you results in around 30 minutes.

If your rapid test is positive you won't be able to attend the match.

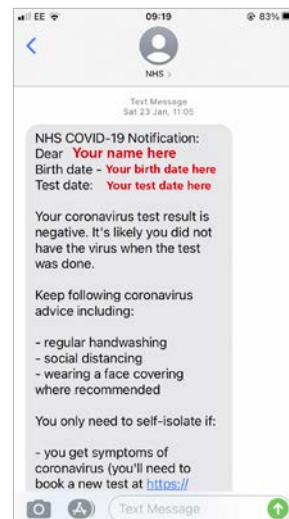
If your rapid test is negative, you need to keep the text or email you'll get as proof and show this on entry.

## What you'll need to show to get entry to the match

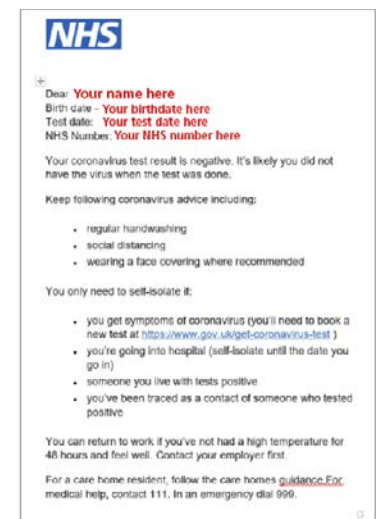
You'll need to show your e-ticket and ID to enter. These will be checked on arrival. You may also be asked to provide evidence of your negative tests or that you have registered your PCR test. Please have them ready to show at the gate to keep the queues moving:

**1 – Your text or email that says you've had a negative COVID (PCR) test.**

Text will look like this:

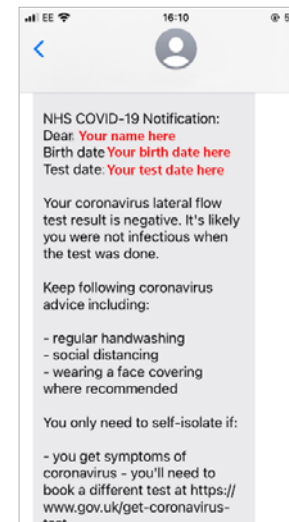

**2 – The email or text you received when you uploaded your negative rapid test (LFT) result to the UK Government website.**
