

GDPR Privacy Statement – Test Event

Who is collecting my data?

The Club (Cardiff City FC) together with the Football Association of Wales (FAW) are both the Data Controllers and Processors of certain personal data such as First name, last name, Address, postcode, gender, Date of Birth, and data relating to the taking of medical tests in relation to the COVID-19 pandemic and the results of those tests. In relation to the processing of this data, at certain stages, either or both entities may be a Data Controller. It is a condition of entry that data may be used by FAW partners in this event for evaluation purposes.

Where appropriate, data will be used to provide details to Track, Trace and Protect.

Testing

To be admitted to the event all attendees will have to complete a polymerase chain reaction (PCR) test five days prior to the event.

A further COVID-19 lateral flow test (LFT) must be completed at home, in the 24 hours before the event.

Why are we collecting your data?

We are collecting certain of the data, specifically that in relation to COVID-19 tests, to prevent the attendance of persons that might be affected by the COVID-19 virus, in so far as is currently known to be possible.

What is the legal basis for processing my data?

The Data Controller relies upon UK. GDPR Art. 6 (1) b processing is necessary for the performance of a contract to which the data subject is party or to take steps at the request of the data subject prior to entering a contract.

In relation to the health data, the Controller may also rely upon UK. GDPR Art. 9 (2) h. processing is necessary for the purposes of preventive or occupational medicine, for the assessment of the working capacity of the employee, medical diagnosis, the provision of health or social care or treatment or the management of health or social care systems and services on the basis of domestic law or pursuant to contract with a health professional and subject to the conditions and safeguards.

How secure is your information?

The Clubs own systems and those of any third-party service providers are required to take appropriate security measures to protect your personal data in line with our policies. We do not allow our third-party service providers to use your personal data for their own purposes unless they are data controllers in relation to your personal data.

Consent

This event is one of a series of Welsh Government Test Event Series.

You must consent to the sharing of information gathered as part of the Welsh Government Test Event Series.

You must consent to the secondary use of information gathered for analysis as part of the Welsh Government Test Event Series.

What will happen if I do not provide this data?

If you do not provide the required data, you will not be allowed to attend the event.

How long will my data be held?

We process registration data for as long as you are an active user and for up to 6 years after this. An active user is a fan that has opened an email from us or bought something from us within the last 3 seasons.

Where we process personal data in connection with performing a contract or for a competition, we keep the data for 6 years from your last interaction with us.

Where we process CCTV footage, we hold this for a month.

Where we process personal data to meet legal requirements, we hold this for as long as the law requires – for example, we hold health and safety accident records for 7 years.

What are your data protection rights?

You have rights over your personal data under the UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR) and the Data Protection Act 2018 (DPA 2018). The Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) is the supervisory authority for data protection legislation and maintains a full explanation of these rights on their website.
